CIRCULAR LETTER TO ALL MEMBER COMPANIES

Re: <u>Workers Compensation Insurance</u>

Unit Statistical Report Rejections

In an effort to improve the quality of the data used in experience ratings and to expedite the timeliness of communicating to carriers the errors in unit statistical data, changes are continuously being made to our reporting requirements.

Effective June 4, 2004, the Workers Compensation Department of the North Carolina Rate Bureau will begin sending unit statistical rejection reports to carriers indicating the field(s) failing the data quality edits for North Carolina.

North Carolina has state specific edits that may cause a unit report to fail in the system that did not fail when submitted to NCCI. All unit reports containing errors will be assigned a status of "Rejected". Rejected units will be considered in error and will not be processed into the system. If you are a carrier that reports unit statistical data directly to NCRB, a correction report must be submitted directly to our office in order to have met the requirements for filing a unit report. If you are a carrier that reports unit statistical data directly to NCCI, a correction report must be submitted directly to NCCI in order to have met the requirements for filing a unit report.

For information on data element coding specifications, please refer to Appendix C of the NC Statistical Plan Manual, located on our website at <u>http://www.ncrb.org</u>, under *Workers Comp Services*. A sample of the report that will be sent to you is attached. You can expect to receive a report for every unit data submission received that contains errors. A follow up report will be sent notifying carriers of any unit reports with a previous status of rejected.
