NORTH CAROLINA REINSURANCE FACILITY STATEMENT OF ELIGIBILITY FOR CESSION OF HIGHER COVERAGE LIMITS – COMMERCIAL COVERAGES

The statutes creating the North Carolina Reinsurance Facility authorize the Facility to accept bodily injury and property damage liability limits up to 100/300/50. The Facility is further authorized to:

"accept motor vehicle insurance or financial responsibility limits in the amounts required by any federal law or federal agency regulation; by any law of this state; or by any rule duly adopted under Chapter 150B or by the North Carolina Utilities Commission."

A North Carolina policy, otherwise eligible for cession to the Facility, with coverage limits above 100/300/50 may be issued and the policy remain eligible for cession to the Facility provided such higher coverage limits are required by any federal law or federal agency regulation, by any law of this state, or by any rule duly adopted under Chapter 150B of the General Statutes or by the North Carolina Utilities Commission.
