CIRCULAR LETTER TO ALL MEMBER COMPANIES

Re: Workers Compensation Insurance Item E-1315(NC) - Graduated Experience Rating The Bureau has adopted and the North Carolina Commissioner of Insurance has approved changes to the experience rating plan formula that will (i) index the minimum ballast value to state benefits and inflation; (ii) provide a lower weighting value for smaller insureds and (iii) introduce a formula for limiting the maximum experience modification for each insured. Changes in the experience rating plan formula will primarily impact only small insureds. The revised formula reduces the weight and increases the ballast for small insureds and thus, gives less credibility to the small insureds= experience. Changes proposed by the captioned Item have been approved to be applicable to experience ratings effective on and after October 1, 1996.
