



## 2013 Class Code Changes- North Carolina

*Effective 4/1/2013*

The industries impacted by Class Code changes effective 4/1/13 are:

- **Telecommunications, Burglar and Fire Alarm & Electronics Installation, Service & Repair**
- **Carpentry- Dwellings- Three Stories or Less**

### Telecommunications, Burglar and Fire Alarm & Electronics Installation, Service & Repair

The following Class Codes have completed their 3-year transition, have been discontinued and exposure assigned to Class Code **7600- Telephone or Telegraph Co.: All Other Employees & Drivers**:

- 7601- *Telephone, Telegraph or Fire Alarm Line Construction & Drivers*
- 7611- *Telephone or Cable TV Line Installation- Contractors, Underground & Drivers*
- 7612- *Telephone or Cable TV Line Installation- Contractors, Overhead & Drivers*
- 7613- *Telephone or Cable TV Line Installation- Contractors, Service Lines and Connections & Drivers*

Phraseologies for the following Class Codes have been revised to read:

- 7600- *Telecommunications Co.- Cable TV, or Satellite- All Other Employees & Drivers*
- 7605- *Burglar and Fire Alarm Installation or Repair & Drivers*
- 8901- *Telecommunications Co.- Office or Exchange Employees & Clerical*
- 9516- *Electronic Equipment- Installation, Service or Repair, Shop and Outside & Drivers*

## Carpentry- Dwellings- Three Stories or Less

**Class Code 5651- *Carpentry Dwelling- Three Stories or Less*, has completed a 2-year transition, has been discontinued and exposure assigned to Class Code 5645.**

**The following Class Codes have been revised as follows:**

- 5645
  - Phraseology has been revised to read *Carpentry- Construction of Residential Dwellings Not Exceeding Three Stories in Height*
  - Discontinue the following cross-references:
    - Iron or Steel: Erection: Steel Frame-Interior-Light Gauge Steel: By Carpentry Contractors in Connection with the Construction of Detached One or Two-Family Dwellings
    - Vinyl Siding Installation- Detached One- or Two-Family Dwellings
    - Door Installation- Screened- Metal or Wood: Jalousie or Jalousie Screen-Erection; Storm Door or Storm Sash Installation- Wood or Metal; Window Screen or Door Installation- Metal or Wood. (If completed by a specialty contractor, this will be covered under Class Code 5102).
- 5403
  - Create a cross reference phraseology for *Carpentry- Construction of Residential Dwellings Exceeding Three Stories in Height or Commercial Buildings and Structures*.
  - Clarification added that this code is assigned to specialty contractors that install all types of siding on commercial buildings and/or existing dwellings that exceed three stories in height.
  - Discontinue the following cross-references:
    - Iron or Steel: Erection: Steel Frame- Interior- Light-Gauge Steel: By Other Carpentry Contractors
    - Hod Hoist or Construction Elevator Installation, Repair or Removal & Drivers, Derrick or Oil Rig Erecting or Dismantling- All Operations- Wood
    - Vinyl Siding Installation- All Other Buildings or Structures
