CIRCULAR LETTER TO ALL MEMBER COMPANIES

Re: 2026 Annual Data Calls

Each year, the North Carolina Rate Bureau, the North Carolina Reinsurance Facility and the North Carolina Insurance Guaranty Association issue data calls to support our organizations. The data we collect is used across the organizations for assessments, expense allowances, and rate filings. This circular outlines data calls, due dates, and where to find additional support. In North Carolina, these data calls use the IDC (Insurance Data Collection) system to collect the data.

Who is Required to Report?

All member carriers who are licensed to write business in North Carolina and are a member of the NCRB, NCRF, and/or the NCIGA are subject to the data calls.

For members of the **IGA Only**, only the Property & Casualty NAIC Annual Statement data call is required. Please see the Data Call Reporting Schedule below.

IDC Access via Web Portal

All member companies are required to use the Industry Data Collection (IDC) web application to submit all data calls. The IDC web application is located on the secure Web Application Portal of the NCRB website www.ncrb.org.

On the NCRB website, click “Member Login” at the top of the page. The WEB APPLICATION PORTAL LOGON page displays. Once logged in, the Web Application Portal allows you to choose *Personal Lines/IDC* to access the system.

If you do not have a LOGON ID for the Web Application Portal, you will need to reach out to your Company’s Master Web Administrator (MWA). For determining your MWA or assistance with logging in, you may reach out to support@ncrb.org or by phone (919) 783-9790.

Please note that it is recommended that organizations confirm their LOGON ID credentials prior to the data call due date to avoid fines for late submission.

Fine Procedures

Fines may be charged, according to the following procedures:

- **Annual Statement and Expense Experience**
To encourage timely submission of this data, the NCRB Governing Committee has approved the implementation of a penalty fine for the late submission of these data calls. A penalty fine of \$100 per day will be imposed for late submissions. The \$100 per day fine is imposed for the Annual Statement, Insurance Expense Exhibit, Installment Premium Charges, and Expense Experience data calls. Member companies are urged to meet the requested due dates to avoid late penalty (submission) fines.
- **Commercial Auto Ceded Statistical**
To encourage timely submission of this data, the NCRF Board of Governors has approved the implementation of a Penalty for Late Submission of Requested Data. A penalty of \$100 per day will be imposed for all late submissions. Member companies are urged to meet the requested due date to avoid the penalty for a late submission.
