

NORTH CAROLINA REINSURANCE FACILITY
STATEMENT OF ELIGIBILITY FOR CESSION OF HIGHER COVERAGE LIMITS

The Reinsurance Facility law provides that the Facility shall accept:

". . . motor vehicle insurance or financial responsibility limits in the amounts required by any federal law or federal agency regulation; by any law of this state; or by any rule duly adopted under Chapter 150B of the General Statutes or by the North Carolina utilities Commission."

If coverage limits above 100/300/50 are to be ceded to the Reinsurance Facility and the coverage limits are required by rule, law or regulation other than the Vehicle Financial Responsibility Act of 1957 (Article 13, Chapter 20, General Statutes of North Carolina), the insured and agent must complete and sign this form. A signed copy of this form must be retained in the ceding carrier's file.
