



Checklist for Companies Starting to Write Auto Liability Insurance in NC

Welcome to the North Carolina Reinsurance Facility. We have developed this checklist as a guideline to assist new companies that intend to begin writing automobile liability insurance in North Carolina and will need to report information to the Facility.

- 1. APPLY FOR NCRF MEMBERSHIP:** Your Company will automatically receive a Membership Packet from Joan Alessandri of Membership Services, upon becoming licensed to write auto liability insurance in North Carolina. Companies are not required to join the North Carolina Reinsurance Facility, unless you are actually writing auto liability insurance in North Carolina. If the company became licensed in the past, but did not become a member and are starting to write auto liability insurance in North Carolina at this time, the company can request a Membership Packet from Membership@ncrb.org.

Complete the necessary forms and return them with your membership fee to:

When the appropriate forms and membership fee have been received, it will take approximately 1 week for the process to be completed. The Company will be notified of the NCRF company code that has been assigned to the company.

Forms to be completed:

- **Membership Application Form**
- **NCRF Company Code Issues (Form NCRF-44)** – Form to determine whether if the company wants to report to the Facility as a stand-alone company or group it with an existing company that is already a member of the Facility.
- **Request for Member Company Address Information (Form NCRF-43)** – Does not need to be filled out if the company is being assigned the same NCRF code as an existing company in the Facility. We would already have contacts on file.
- **Authorization Agreement for ACH Deposits (Credits)**

2. **BECOME FAMILIAR WITH OUR WEBSITE:** Visit our website at www.ncrb.org/ncrf for the NCRF Standard Practice Manual, FTP Instruction Guide, Circular Letters, FAQ's and other information needed as a Facility member. There is also information about using our online system EDGE and detailed information on how to contact us.
3. **SET UP ORIENTATION CALL WITH NCRF MANAGEMENT:** This will give the company the opportunity to ask questions about NCRF. To coordinate the orientation email NCRFOperations@ncrb.org.
4. **NOTIFY NCRF OF YOUR START DATE:** The company should email NCRFOperations@ncrb.org with the projected date that they will begin writing auto liability insurance coverage in North Carolina.
5. **SETUP YOUR ONLINE ACCESS ACCOUNTS:** To obtain an online user account from the NCRB-NCRF-NCIGA Member Services site, each company is required to establish a Master Web Administrator (MWA). This self-service account management policy allows members to grant and control users' access to information sensitive to their organization. If the company did not set up an MWA when they joined the North Carolina Rate Bureau, please complete the online registration on our website. The Member Services links are located on the right-hand side of the page. If the MWA has been established, that person would need to grant access to EDGE for each individual user in your organization.
6. **SETUP FTP ACCOUNT:** In preparation for issuing auto liability policies in North Carolina, the company will need to set up an FTP account to submit cession, accounting and recoupment data to the EDGE system. On our website, under the EDGE tab, click on FTP Transmissions to find the FTP Account Request Form. Complete this form and email it to ftpsupport@ncrb.org. **(Please note that companies may manually enter cessions online, but during any business interruption at the Facility that causes EDGE online services to be unavailable, FTP services continue without interruption and are the only way to report cessions and preserve the earliest receipt date).**

Companies should give themselves at least 2 months to set up and test FTP files for cession, accounting and recoupment data. The length of time can vary based on whether the company already has FTP software in place, the expertise of the technical resources and internal development policies in place at the company.

Companies will not be considered as production ready, until all applicable files have been tested and approved. A mutually agreeable date will be selected at which point the member company can begin transmitting "Production" files via FTP. This start date will be confirmed

in an email from our FTP Support. **(Please refer to the NCRF FTP Instruction Guide on our website).** To begin testing FTP files, please contact ftpsupport@ncrb.org. Please copy NCRFOperations@ncrb.org.

- 7. REQUEST CEDING AND EXPENSE ALLOWANCES:** Companies can request their ceding and claims expense allowances, please contact Kevin Braswell at kdb@ncrb.org or (919) 719-3029.
